Air Mauritius recruits new cabin crew



Air Mauritius has recently recruited more than 35 cabin crew to join its existing team of some 490 stewards and hostesses to ensure its smooth operations. The CEO Mr Raj Bungraz has been personally involved in the recruitment process and gave the necessary support to accelerate the employment of additional fresh resources with a view to enhance customer service.

The new recruits will undergo normal training in Safety and Emergency Procedures as well as customer service and be thoroughly tested before starting to serve as cabin crew. At a briefing session yesterday, the CEO congratulated the new recruits and wished them success in their training. Mr Bungraz has also announced that a new recruitment exercise for cabin crew will be launched shortly.

Air Mauritius is the national carrier of the Republic of Mauritius. Created in 1967, it currently operates a fleet of four A340-300, two A340-300E, two A330-200, two A319-100 and two ATR72-500. Air Mauritius presently flies to twenty-five destinations in Europe, Asia, Australia, Africa and the Indian Ocean
