Air Mauritius A319 repairs completed ahead of schedule

Air Mauritius A319 – registration 3BNBH – leaves Abu Dhabi tonight after repairs completed ahead of schedule.

Our aircraft had suffered some damage following the fire at GAMCO facilities on the 19th of April 2007. The repair works were conducted by GAMCO under the supervision of an Air Mauritius team after validation by the aircraft manufacturer, Airbus Industrie. The aircraft will be back into commercial operations as from Sunday 13th May 2007.

Manoj R K Ujoodha, Air Mauritius' Chief Executive Officer says “We are pleased that the A319 was repaired ahead of schedule. Our gratitude goes to the teams at GAMCO, Airbus Industrie and our own team for the efforts made to ensure the repairs were effected well within the deadline and to ensure the aircraft is ready to resume safe operations”
