

## ARTICLES PROHIBITED IN THE CABIN

Items falling under the following categories will not be allowed in the cabin:

### A) GUNS, FIREARMS AND OTHER DEVICES THAT DISCHARGE PROJECTILES

Devices designed to cause serious injury by discharging a projectile, or capable of being mistaken for such devices.

### B) STUNNING DEVICES

Devices designed specifically to stun or immobilize

### C) OBJECTS WITH SHARP POINTS OR SHARP EDGES

Objects with a sharp point or sharp edge capable of being used to cause serious injury

### D) WORKERS TOOLS

Tools capable of being used either to cause serious injury or to threaten the safety of aircraft.

### E) BLUNT INSTRUMENTS

Objects capable of being used to cause serious injury when used to hit.

### F) EXPLOSIVE AND INCENDIARY SUBSTANCES AND DEVICES

Explosive or incendiary substances or devices capable of being used to cause serious injury or threatening the safety of the aircraft.

### G) LIQUID, AEROSOL AND GELS

Liquids, aerosols and gels, unless in individual containers with a capacity not greater than 100 milliliters (or equivalent) and contained in one transparent re-sealable plastic bag of a capacity not exceeding 1 liter (or equivalent). The contents of the plastic bag shall fit comfortably and the bag shall be completely closed. Exemptions apply for medications, baby milk/foods and special dietary requirements.
