JOB PROFILE:

The main responsibility of the Cabin Interior Assistant is to inspect and repair cabin items and related cabin equipment, as well as fabricate/install/refurbish aircraft interior fabrics. He/She will also be required to provide assistance and support to Cabin Technicians and Supervisors during maintenance activities.

The duties and responsibilities will include the following inter-alia:

- Fabricate, install and refurbish aircraft interior equipment and furnishings as per work order, including but not limited to items such as textile and non-textile flooring, upholstery on seats, baby bassinets and curtains;
- Responsible for pattern making, cutting seat coverings, sewing using multiple types of stitching, carpet cutting and surging;
- Set up and operate tools to cut, cover and complete components of the job;
- Strip and re-cover seats and their components;
- Carry out inspection, repair and maintenance of aircraft cabin items such as but not limited to seat covers, curtains, seat belts, trim and finish items and side walls.

PREREQUISITES:

School Certificate (SC) or General Certificate Education (GCE) "O" level, with at least 5 subjects obtained at one and same sitting or an equivalent qualification from a recognized institution.

Plus one of the following Technical Qualifications or an equivalent qualification acceptable to Air Mauritius: -

- National Certificate Level 4 in Automotive Mechanics
- National Certificate Level 4 in Electronics
