## Senior Operations Officer – Ramp Services

The duties and responsibilities will include the following inter-alia:

- Ensure safe and secure aircraft operations by following all safety procedures and securing the aircraft upon arrival.
- Supervise and support ramp staff during aircraft handling activities, promoting safe practices in compliance with industry standards.
- Carry out aircraft walk-around checks during arrival and departure and perform key ground tasks such as marshalling and communication.
- Coordinate all ramp activities including proper use and positioning of ground support equipment (GSE) and ensuring equipment and Unit Load Devices (ULD) are serviceable and well-maintained.
- Oversee accurate and timely loading and unloading of baggage, cargo, and special loads in line with airline procedures.
- Maintain effective communication with all stakeholders to support a smooth aircraft turnaround, and ensure orderly housekeeping of ramp and equipment areas.
