The Trainee Assistant Technician - Structures will assist authorized personnel in the assembly, inspection, troubleshooting and testing of aircraft components in accordance with Mauritian and European Aviation Part 145 Requirements. Additionally, the Trainee Assistant Technician - Structures will assist in performing repairs on aircraft and aircraft components.

The duties and responsibilities will include the following inter-alia:

- Assist in performing blending of metal on aircraft structures or aircraft component.
- Assist in performing drilling on aircraft structures or aircraft components.
- Assist in performing riveting on aircraft structures or aircraft component.
- Assist in performing blending of metal on aircraft or aircraft components.
- Assist in cutting, forming, putting to size and fitment of metal patch on aircraft.
- Assist in performing disassembly/ cleaning/assembly and testing of Life Vests/Life Jackets.
- Assist in performing Leak check on Life Vest/Life Jackets.
- Assist in safely storing all assigned tools and equipment to designated locations and house keeping.
