JOB PROFILE:

The main responsibility of the Trainee Technical Assistant – Avionics Component will assist authorised personnel in the assembly, inspection, troubleshooting, testing and maintenance repair of aircraft components, in compliance with Mauritian and European Aviation Part 145 requirements.

The duties and responsibilities will include the following inter-alia:

- Assist in performing inspection/disassembly/cleaning/assembly and testing of aircraft battery (Ni-Cd and Li-ion battery)
 - Use of Test Bench
- Assist in carrying out Battery Sensors test
- Assist in troubleshooting and testing of electronics/electrical parts (Headset/ Microphone)
 - Use of test equipment e.g. meters and oscilloscope
- Assist in performing inspection/disassembly/cleaning/assembly and testing of Aircraft Ovens/Chillers/Boilers/Beverage makers
 - Use of Test Bench
- Assist in performing test and repair on In Flight Entertainment (IFE) Equipment i.e. (Cradle/SEB/Monitors) and Emergency Power Supplies
- Assist in safely storing all assigned tools and equipment to designated locations and housekeeping
- Assist in updating documents
- Assist in recording all work performed
- Assist in tools inventories and periodical check/maintenance of tools/equipment
- Assist in incoming inspections and dispatch of components to Aircraft stores
