JOB PROFILE:

The main responsibility of the Trainee Technical Assistant – Cabin Maintenance will be to assist qualified Cabin Technicians to perform inspection, troubleshooting, tests and rectification of cabin interior systems during maintenance activities.

The duties and responsibilities will include the following inter-alia:

- Assist Cabin Technicians/Certifying Staff/Support Staff to carry out cabin maintenance activities on aircraft including but not limited to seats, toilet system, galley equipment and In-Flight Entertainment System
- Provide adequate support to maintain aircraft's cabin appearance in line with the department's cabin standards and appearance manual and other applicable standard
- Keep track of cabin defects, monitor overall cabin condition and propose improvements and innovative ideas to fix defects
- Carry out work in a safe manner and achieve the best quality standard with respect to any maintenance task performed using updated and approved data
- Ensure that over and above specifically allocated tasks on an aircraft, at all times, look for defects and report to immediate superior to ensure proper action to address these defects
- Ensure good general working practices: working with the appropriate serviceable tools and equipment; cleanliness of premises, equipment, work areas and surroundings.
