

**NOTICE TO CREDITORS OF AIR MAURITIUS LIMITED (ADMINISTRATORS APPOINTED)
(THE “COMPANY”)**

Following the first creditors’ meeting which took place on 04 May 2020, Messrs Sattar Hajee Abdoula and Arvindsingh Gokhool (both referred to as the “Administrators”) are continuing their investigation of the Company’s affairs with the aim of proposing a plan at the watershed meeting to rescue the Company or as much of its business as possible. The Bankruptcy Division of the Supreme Court of Mauritius has granted the Administrators until 30 November 2020 to convene the watershed meeting and it is scheduled to be held within seven days of that date.

All persons who have a claim against the Company, whether actual, prospective or contingent, are required to file a claim form with the Administrators by sending the claim form and all documents evidencing the claim at mk.claim@mu.gt.com. Creditors who have already submitted a statement of claim, need **not** resubmit your claims unless you anticipate that there will be changes to the amount of your claim until 30 November 2020, in which case you need to send to the Administrators particulars of the changes together with supporting documents at mk.claim@mu.gt.com.

Given the size and complexity of the operations of the Company, the Administrators require sufficient time to properly review and assess the numerous claims that are expected to be filed against the Company. Therefore, the deadline for filing claims against the Company shall be 11:00 pm (Mauritian time) on 31 August 2020, although claimants are encouraged to file their claim forms and supporting documents as soon as possible.

The Administrators may, in their absolute discretion and only in the most exceptional circumstances, accept a claim form and documents which are filed after that deadline.

The mere fact that a claimant has sent a claim form and supporting documents does not automatically mean that the Administrators accept such claim as being a valid claim against the Company, or the amount of the claim. This is for the Administrators to determine, in accordance with law. The Administrators reserve their rights to require further information, clarification or documents from any claimant in carrying out the assessment of claims.

The Administrators may reject any claim in respect of which no claim form has been sent prior to the above deadline of 11:00 pm (Mauritian time) on 31 August 2020. They may also reject any claim in respect of which no or no sufficient supporting document(s) have been provided, or which is otherwise not substantiated.
