Instructions to claimants

1. If you believe that you are an actual, prospective or contingent creditor of the Company, you are invited to complete the above form of claim and send it to the Administrators of the Company at mk.claim@mu.gt.com, latest by 11.00 pm (Mauritian time) on 31 August 2020.
2. It is essential, in order for the Administrators and their legal and financial teams to review and decide on the validity of your claim, that you send all supporting documents which evidence your claim against the Company and its amount, including but not limited to contracts, invoices and written correspondences with the Company.
3. Once your claim has been received, the Administrators and their teams will examine the claim and the supporting documents you have provided. The Administrators reserve their rights to request any additional information, clarification and/or document from you in order to ascertain the validity of your claim against the Company.
4. Given the size and complexity of the operations of the Company, the Administrators will need sufficient time in order to review and assess numerous claims that are made against the Company. In order to be able to do so properly before the watershed meeting, expected to take place in early December 2020, claim forms should be received by the Administrators no later than 11.00 pm (Mauritian time) on 31 August 2020. Creditors are however encouraged to send their claim forms as soon as possible as from now so that the Administrators can already start processing them. The Administrators may, in their absolute discretion and only in the most exceptional circumstances, extend the above deadline.
5. The mere sending of a claim form and documents by you and receipt thereof by the Administrators shall not amount to an acceptance by the Administrators of your claim against the Company.
6. The Administrators reserve their rights to reject any claim against a Company in respect of which a claim form and supporting documents have not been sent to the Administrators on or prior to 11.00 pm (Mauritian time) on 31 August 2020. The Administrators may also reject any claim in respect of which no or no sufficient supporting document(s) have been provided to them.
7. Should you have any query on the status of your claim form and the process of administration generally, you may send it by email to mk.claim@mu.gt.com and the Administrators shall endeavour to respond to you within the shortest possible delay.
