Air Mauritius wishes to inform all passengers that with additional travel restrictions now in force in Mauritius due to the outbreak of Covid-19, flights to and from Mauritius are being suspended as below. As mentioned in our previous communique, with the travel restrictions now in force, passengers will not be uplifted on inbound flights to Mauritius.

Thereafter all flights, except flights for Rodrigues, will be suspended until 30 April 2020, depending upon future developments.
