Travel Protocol/Standard Operating Protocol for PCR Tests for Indian workers travelling to Mauritius

1. **TWO** PCR tests will have to be carried out prior to travelling at accredited centres by qualified health practitioners. The testing by ICMR approved lab is indicated in the link https://www.icmr.gov.in/pdf/covid/labs/COVID_Testing_labs_04102020.pdf.
2. The first test will be carried out five days prior to travelling from the State of residence of the worker to the State from which he will depart for Mauritius. In the state from which the worker will depart for Mauritius, a second test will be carried out, 2 days before the scheduled flight. In between the two tests, the worker should be isolated from all external contact in an appropriate accommodation, near the International Airport area.
3. Tests should be carried out at the same area of the International Airport.
4. For passengers originating from the same state as that where the airport is located, the same conditions apply, including the obligation of undertaking 2 tests and the isolation period to be observed prior to departure.
5. The transfer of workers to the International Airport prior to flights to Mauritius should be carried out in compliance with all COVID-19 sanitary protocols.
6. Travellers (workers) should wear their face mask at all time in the plane.
7. Workers must carry personal hand sanitizers with them.
